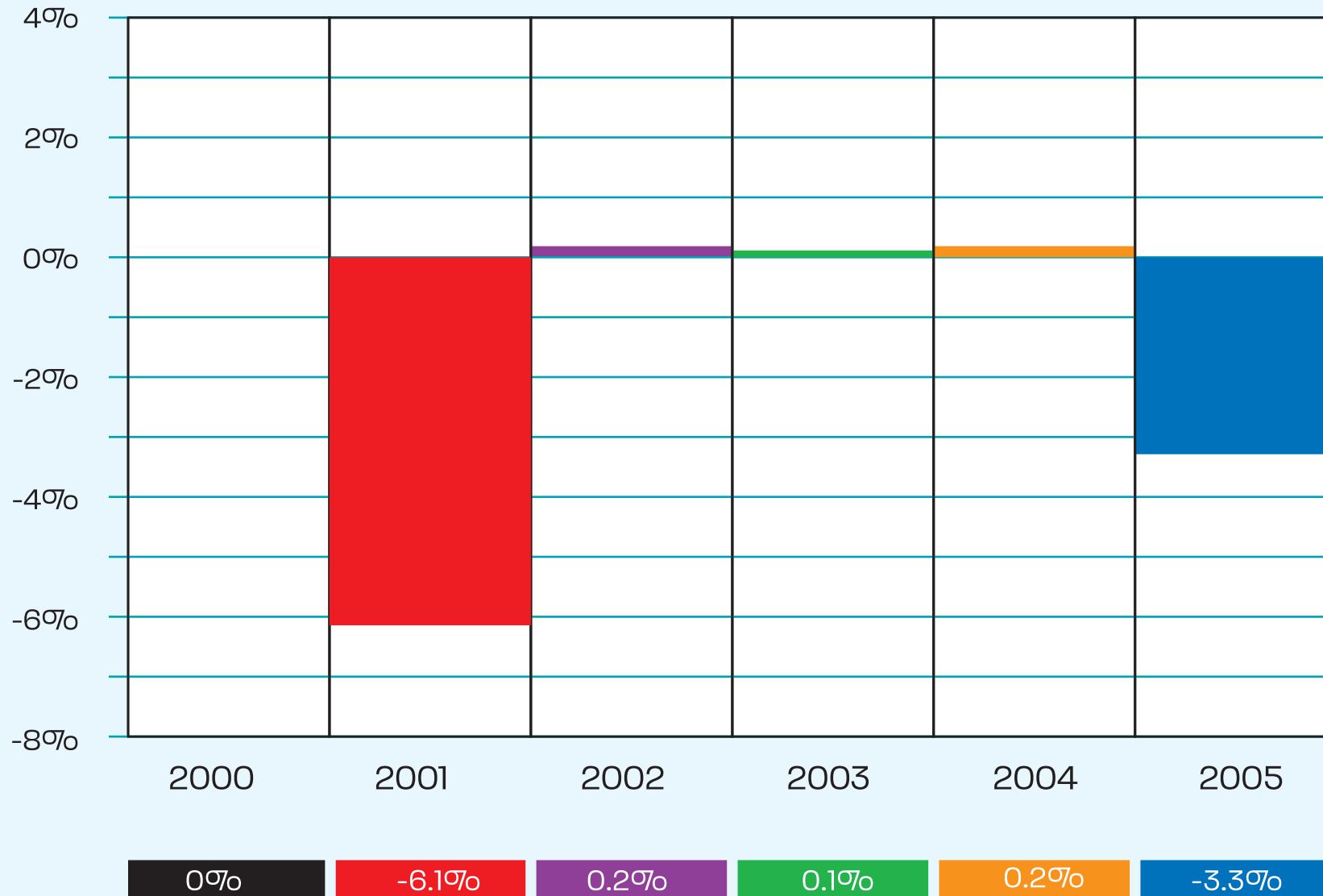
The highest percentage of household recyclables is waste paper, up to 80%

- 5 Growth in global demand

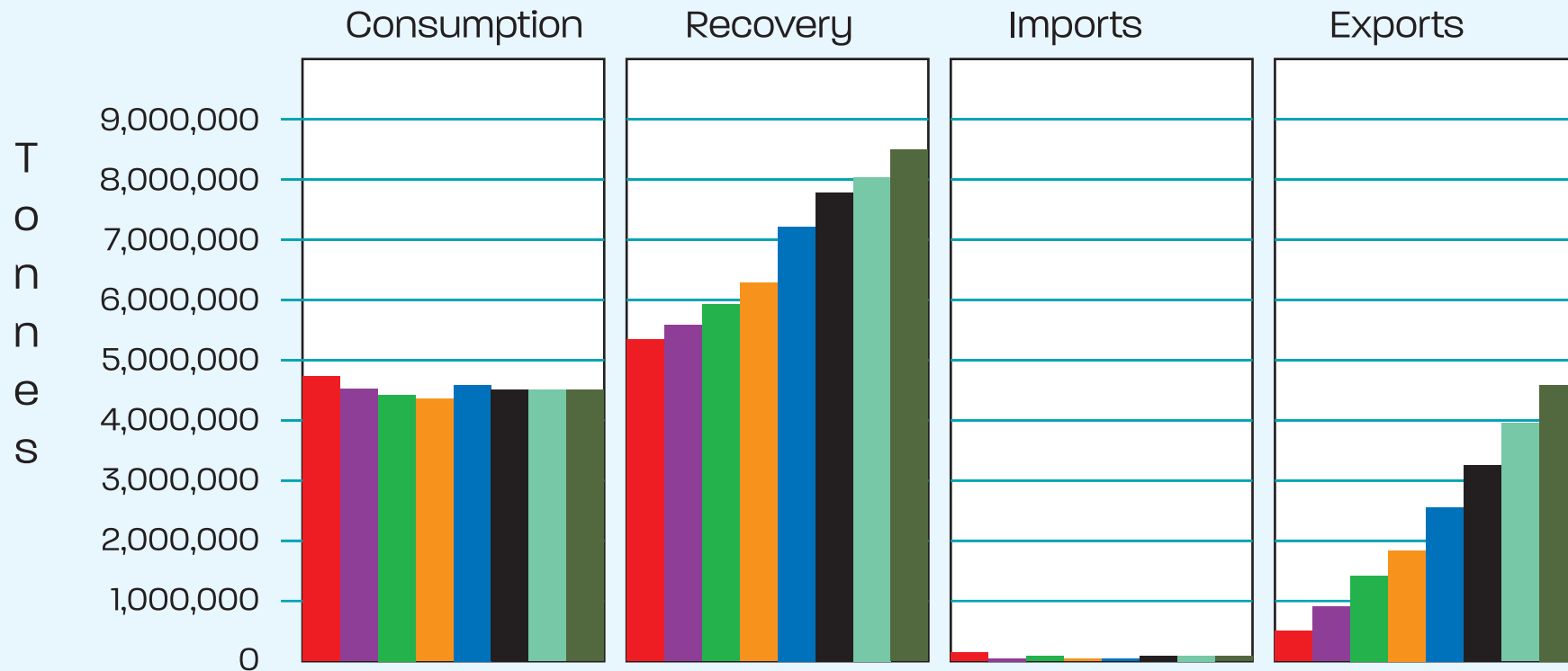
The Five Major Global Markets for Recovered Paper
